Dear Parent/Carer

I am writing with an update regarding GCSE assessment in light of the outcomes of the exam consultation which was published yesterday. Many reports in the media yesterday implied the whole process of grading would be left exclusively to teachers. Whilst accurate, yes, your child's teacher will be responsible for awarding the grade, teachers will have a number of rules to adhere to and evidence to support grades will be essential. Additionally, grades submitted will undergo quality assurance by the exam boards and samples of work may be called for. Therefore, is it crucial students recognise, that whilst external exams are cancelled, we will need to continue to assess them in school.

We now await subject specific information from each exam board regarding grading and assessment. We believe we will receive this before the end of the Spring Term. What we do know is that ongoing assessments we complete in class may be used to supplement our evidence base for each student. We will continue to inform students which work might be used to inform their final grade. Nationally, the final deadline for submission of grades is 18th June, and we will strive to give all students every opportunity between now and then to demonstrate their skills and knowledge.
