Dear Parent/Carer,

On 16th January the NEU, one of the Trade Unions representing the teaching profession announced its intention to strike.

The intended strike dates that will impact on the provision at Ruskin are:

Wednesday 1st February (National)
Tuesday 28th February (Regional)
Wednesday 15th March (National)
Thursday 16th March (National)

I am unable to share with you the extent of the impact of the industrial action and I will communicate with you when I am clear of the impact this will cause regarding safely functioning on strike days.

The decision to open, restrict attendance or close the school will be made as soon as possible.

Any decision made to restrict attendance or close will ensure that staff and students are not exposed to risks to their health and safety.

Following DfE guidance if we need to restrict attendance we have been asked to prioritise vulnerable children, children of critical workers and students who are due to take public examinations and other formal assessments.

I will write to you again in due course before 1st February when we have been able to decide on prioritisation of student's attendance based upon staff availability and DfE guidance.
