

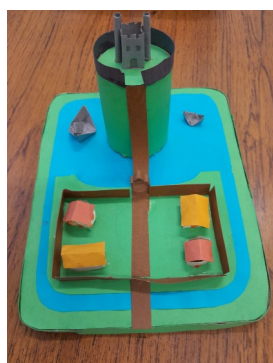

Key Stage 3

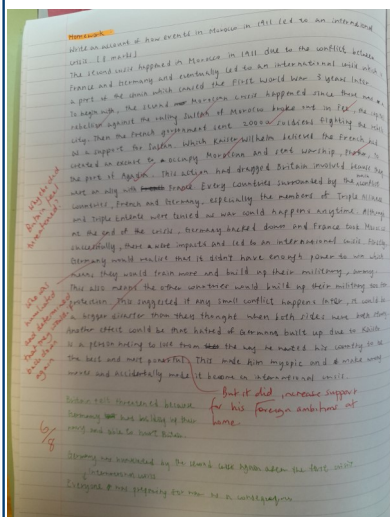
This term the Year 7s have been looking at the events of 1066 including the Battle of Hastings and William the Conqueror. The homework has been to produce a model of a motte and bailey castle – in any material! The castles are all due in at the end of term and the most impressive will win a prize – see our social media in December. Year 8 have been learning about the Industrial Revolution and the conditions in factories in the 19th Century – somehow going to school doesn't seem that bad



Year 9s have been studying the Holocaust – this is statutory in Key Stage 3. They have coped well with this very emotive topic and their assessments have demonstrated real understanding of the horrors of the time.

Key Stage 4

Our Year 10s have begun their GCSE History and made a smashing start. We are currently looking at the reign of the Tudor Queen Elizabeth I. The work produced has been exceptional – we have a cohort that are showing real skills and interest in History.



Year 11 have done well in their mock exams on the whole. Revision is certainly the key to success: some students have achieved Grades 8 and 9! We are currently studying the final unit – the First World War. Over the Christmas break we hope that students continue to revise all 4 topics...the exams are only 6 months away!
