This term in Religious Studies...


Year 7 and 8


Year 7s students have delved into engaging Jewish stories including; Abraham's covenant and ultimate test and Moses' miracles. Students have explored the morals behind each story to discover if any teachings are similar to their own worldviews.

Year 8s have began studying the oldest world religion; Hinduism. They have explored complex concepts including; polytheism, monotheism, karma, samsara, re-birth and moksha. Students have reflected on these concepts to see if any coincide with their personal moral compass.

Year 9: Philosophy and Ethics

Year 9s are studying Philosophy and Ethics this year. They've answered the question 'Is it logical to believe in God?' through exploration of philosophical themes. Students are now studying ethics through the following case studies of; Cloning, Robots and A.I, Black Lives Matter and Climate Activism. The aim of this term in RS is to develop students' ability to critically think and understand differing perspectives.
