Year 11 Student Study Day – Wednesday 4 March 2026

We are pleased to inform you that your child has been given the opportunity to attend an additional mathematics study day. This event is designed to support students who are taking the higher tier Mathematics GCSE exams. It will take place on Wednesday 4 March 2026 at Chester University.

Students will attend lectures on vectors, iteration and statistical graphs. All students who attended the course in January found it beneficial in helping them prepare for problem solving questions they will encounter in their Maths GCSE.

Fifteen students from Ruskin Community High School have been selected and they will be accompanied by Mr Ledwards (Year Achievement Manager: Head of Year 11) and an additional teacher.

Mr Ledwards will accompany the students on the train to Chester from Crewe station. As previously, students should arrive at Crewe train station by 8am in full school uniform on Wednesday 4th March. All students are to bring full school equipment (calculator, pens, maths book) and a packed lunch, however those on Free School Meals will be allocated a grab bag for the day. Mr Ledwards will register and students will return to Crewe train station by 3.30pm on the same day. Students are responsible for making their own way to and from Crewe train station.

The parental contribution for the trip/visit, including transport, is £10, which represents extremely good value for the visit. If you have any problems making payments, please contact the school office or trip organiser.

To secure your child a place on this trip please sign up & pay on the School Gateway App by Monday, 2nd of March. Please ensure we have the most up to date contact information and medical details prior to the trip. You can inform us of any changes via the School Gateway App or at the Main office.

In exceptional circumstances a place on a trip may be withdrawn, in which case any monies paid will be refunded in full.
